


Navigating the new Learning Link

On 1 April 2026 NGA is launching a brand-new Learning Link platform designed to make it easier to find, access and manage your learning. Key improvements include:


- Quicker and easier access to modules

What you need to do


Module navigation menu

This module page will look familiar: with the usual player and **module controls** in the main window (pictured on the right). There is also a **module navigation menu** to help you move between units.




As you complete each unit, it will be ticked off. Click **'Proceed'** at the end of each unit to continue to the next unit or complete the module.
