During the year, we have championed the cause of governance. We can summarise our involvement as follows.

- Work with the Local Authority We hold meetings of the Executive of the Association, and, at many meetings, a senior member of the Local Authority team attends to talk about issues in their particular area of expertise. This allows the Executive to understand and influence policy. The Executive wishes to place on record their thanks to the senior managers of the Local Authority for attending these meetings.
